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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 16, Subchapter 1, is amended
24 to add an additional section to read as follows:

25 6-16-152. Civics education – Required.

26 (a)(1) Beginning with the entering ninth grade class of the 2021-2022
27 school year, each high school student shall be required before graduation to
28 earn one (1) credit in a course taken in grade nine (9), grade ten (10),
29 grade eleven (11), or grade twelve (12) that includes civics education.

30 (2) The civics education course required under subdivision
31 (a)(1) of this section shall:

32 (A) Consist of a minimum of two (2) full semesters within
33 the same academic year; and

34 (B) Result in the award of one (1) unit of credit towards
35 graduation requirements.

36 (b) The Division of Elementary and Secondary Education shall, in



1 advance of the 2021-2022 school year, develop materials or units relating to
2 civics education required under this section.

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
