24	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 21, Chapt	er 1, Subchapter 1, is amended
25	5 to add an additional section to read as follows	:

28	(a) As used in this section:	
29	9 <u>(1) "State employee" means an indi</u>	vidual employed by a state
30	0 <u>entity</u> ;	
31	l (2) "State entity" means an instru	mentality of state government,
32	including without limitation a board, commission, committee, advisory board,	
33	office, department, institution, bureau, counci	l, administrative program,
34	agency, or division;	
35	(3) "State-owned device or state-1	<u>eased equipment" means a</u>
36	6 device that has been issued or leased by a stat	e entity to a state employee

1	or contractor of the state, including without limitation a mobile device,
2	cellphone, laptop, or any other device capable of internet connectivity; and
3	(4) "TikTok" means a social media platform owned by the Chinese
4	company ByteDance that has the ability to use data collection methods to
5	gather user information, including without limitation internet browsing data,
6	keystrokes, and location information.
7	(b) The General Assembly finds that:
8	(1) The maintenance of cybersecurity in state government is
9	necessary to continue to serve Arkansas citizens;
10	(2) TikTok has more than one billion (1,000,000,000) global
11	users, with over one hundred thirty-five million (135,000,000) of those users
12	located in the United States;
13	(3) Christopher Wray, Director of the Federal Bureau of
14	Investigation, has warned that the data collection practices of ByteDance may
15	be used to influence Americans or control or compromise software on millions
16	of devices;
17	(4) The Communist Party of China may obtain access to this
18	personal information obtained through the data collection policies of
19	ByteDance because ByteDance is headquartered in China and Chinese national
20	security laws compel companies operating in China to share their user
21	information data with the Communist Party of China upon request;
22	(5) Previously, ByteDance refused to stop the flow of user
23	information data to the Communist Party of China despite a request to do so
24	from the Committee on Foreign Investment in the United States;
25	(6) The Communist Party of China may use United States user
26	information data for sensitive intelligence gathering, intellectual property
27	theft, and other illicit purposes;
28	(7) Several government entities, including the United States
29	Armed Forces, the Transportation Security Administration, and the State of
30	South Dakota, have banned downloading or using the TikTok application or
31	visiting the TikTok website on government-issued devices;
32	(8) Officials of the Federal Communications Commission and a
33	bipartisan coalition of United States Senators support a complete ban on
34	TikTok usage due to TikTok's unique national security risks; and
35	(9) Permitting the downloading or usage of the TikTok
36	application or visiting the TikTok website on government-issued cellphones,

3	(c) A state entity or state employee shall not download or use the	
4	TikTok application or visit the TikTok website on a state-owned device or	
5	state-leased equipment.	
6	(d) A person or entity that contracts with the state shall not	
7	download or use the TikTok application or visit the TikTok website on a	
8	state-owned device or state-leased equipment.	
9	(e) Upon conviction, a person that downloads or uses the TikTok	
10	application or visits the TikTok website is guilty of a violation.
