SENATE AMENDMENTS TO S.B. 1059

1 The bill as proposed to be amended is reprinted as follows:

2 Section 1. Efficacy of Arizona's move over law study  
3 committee; membership; duties; report; delayed  
4 repeal

5 A. The efficacy of Arizona's move over law study committee is  
6 established consisting of the following members:

7 1. Two members of the senate, each from a different political  
8 party, who are appointed by the president of the senate. The president of  
9 the senate shall designate one of these members to serve as cochairperson  
10 of the study committee.

11 2. Two members of the house of representatives, each from a  
12 different political party, who are appointed by the speaker of the house  
13 of representatives. The speaker of the house of representatives shall  
14 designate one of these members to serve as cochairperson of the study  
15 committee.

16 3. The director of the department of transportation or the  
17 director's designee.

18 [~~4. Two representatives who are appointed by the department of~~  
19 ~~public safety.~~]

20 [~~4. The director of the department of public safety or the~~  
21 ~~director's designee.~~]

22 5. [~~One representative~~] [~~Three representatives~~] of the towing and  
23 recovery industry [~~who is appointed by the governor~~][~~, one of whom is~~  
24 ~~appointed by the governor, one of whom is appointed by the president of~~  
25 ~~the senate and one of whom is appointed by the speaker of the house of~~  
26 ~~representatives].~~

27 [~~6. Two representatives of law enforcement associations, one of~~  
28 ~~whom is appointed by the president of the senate and one of whom is~~  
29 ~~appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.~~]

1 [7. Two representatives from a local chapter of a nationally  
2 recognized organization that advocates for motor vehicle interests, one of  
3 whom is appointed by the president of the senate and one of whom is  
4 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.]

5 B. The study committee shall meet at the call of the  
6 cochairpersons.

7 C. Study committee members are not eligible to receive  
8 compensation.

9 D. The study committee shall:

10 1. Conduct a comprehensive study to determine the efficacy of  
11 section 28-775, subsection E, Arizona Revised Statutes, to determine if  
12 additional promotion and education of the law are needed to ensure greater  
13 effectiveness and additional safety measures to help drivers better comply  
14 with yielding to emergency vehicles.

15 2. Identify any additional resources or policy initiatives that  
16 would enhance public safety or improve the efficacy of section 28-775,  
17 Arizona Revised Statutes.

18 3. Propose legislation to address issues identified by the study  
19 committee.

20 4. Review current policies and practices and propose revisions to  
21 improve safety matters for first responders and citizens.

22 5. On or before December 1, 2025, submit a report regarding the  
23 study committee's activities, findings and recommendations for  
24 administrative or legislative action to the governor, the president of the  
25 senate and the speaker of the house of representatives and provide a copy  
26 of this report to the secretary of state.

27 E. This section is repealed from and after September 30, 2026.
