HB 2081: income tax; subtraction; tipped wages Sponsor: Representative Griffin, LD 19 Committee on Ways & Means

Overview

Amends the list of subtractions from Arizona gross income to include cash tips.

History

Arizona currently taxes 2.5% of an individual's taxable income (<u>A.R.S. § 43-1011</u>). Taxable income is defined in statute as adjusted gross income less any applicable deductions (<u>A.R.S. § 43-1001</u>).

26 United States Code Section 6053 (a) requires employees to disclose to their employer, via written statement, the amount earned from tips within 10 days of being received ($26 \text{ USC } \\ \underline{\$} \\ \underline$

Provisions

1. Adds cash tips to the list of subtractions from Arizona gross income beginning from and after December 31, 2024. (Sec. 1)
