HB 2445: lawn equipment emissions reduction program

Overview

Allows a county that operates a voluntary lawn and garden equipment emissions reduction program to increase voucher amount for commercial lawn mowers and recipients to use residential lawn mower vouchers for manually operated reel lawn mowers.

History

Statute requires Maricopa and Pima county to create a voluntary lawn and garden equipment emissions reduction program (Program). A person can participate in this Program if their lawn or garden equipment functions and is used for residential or commercial purposes. Participants can receive:

- 1) A \$200 voucher for retiring a commercial lawn mower which they must use to buy a lower emission lawn mower;
- 2) A \$100 voucher for retiring a residential lawn mower which they must use to buy an electric lawn mower; or
- 3) A \$50 voucher for retiring a gasoline-powered lawn or garden device which they must use to buy a similar device that generates lower emissions.

Retired equipment cannot be used in Arizona ([A.R.S. § 49-474.02](#)).

Provisions

1. Requires that vouchers issued to commercial lawn mower owners be at least \$200 instead of just \$200. (Sec. 1)
2. Allows a voucher for a residential lawn mower to be used to purchase a manually operated reel lawn mower. (Sec. 1)
3. Makes a technical change. (Sec. 1)
