FACT SHEET FOR S.B. 1334

fireworks; aerial devices

Purpose

Includes *multiple-tube aerial devices* in the definition of *permissible consumer fireworks* for a county of more than 500,000 persons and prohibits a retail establishment housed in a temporary facility, except for a consumer firework retail sale stand, from selling *permissible consumer fireworks*.

Background

The sale, use or possession of any fireworks is prohibited except as outlined in statute (A.R.S. § 36-1602). Unless prohibited by a county, city or town, the general public may use permissible consumer fireworks and a retail establishment may sell permissible consumer fireworks if the establishment complies with the State Fire Marshall's storage and sale rules. A city, town or county may regulate permissible consumer fireworks in accordance with National Fire Protection Association code 1124 (NPFA 1124) standards and may prohibit the use or retail sale of permissible consumer fireworks except on specified days (A.R.S. §§ 36-1605 and 36-1606).

A *mine and shell device*, as defined by the American Pyrotechnics Association standard 87-1 (APA 87-1) is a heavy cardboard or paper tube usually attached to a base with a maximum total chemical composition of 60 grams. A *mine device* has no internal components containing a burst charge, and a *shell device* contains a component that bursts in the air. A *multiple-tube aerial device* is a firework device that contains more than one cardboard tube securely held together, usually on a base, with a maximum total chemical composition of 200 grams and the ignition of one external fuse causes the tubes to function sequentially (APA 87-1).

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the state General Fund associated with this legislation.

Provisions

- 1. Includes, in the definition of *permissible consumer fireworks* for a county with a population of more than 500,000 persons, *multiple-tube aerial devices*.
- 2. Prohibits a retail establishment housed in a temporary facility, as defined in NFPA 1124, from selling *permissible consumer fireworks*, except for consumer firework retail sale stands.
- 3. Defines *multiple-tube aerial devices* as mine and shell devices and multiple tube fireworks as defined by APA 87-1, except those that include a single-shot device or reloadable aerial shell.
- 4. Makes technical and conforming changes.
- 5. Becomes effective on the general effective date.
