 follows:

5 **42-1-234. Electronic vehicle registration and titling - electronic** 6 **transmission of vehicle lien information - authority - rules - electronic** 7 **transactions fund - gifts, grants, and donations - repeal.** (1) (b) The 8 department's approval of a third-party provider to register a vehicle, or 9 special mobile machinery, file or release liens, or issue any type of 10 certificate of title must be evidenced by an agreement between the 11 department and the third-party provider.

12 (c) In registering a vehicle, or special mobile machinery, filing or 13 releasing liens, or issuing any type of certificate of title, the third-party 14 provider is acting as an agent of the department. The third-party provider 15 shall collect and remit to the department all taxes and fees imposed by 16 law to issue any type of certificate of title, TO file or release a lien, or to 17 register the vehicle. or special mobile machinery.

18 (2) (a) The department is authorized to seek and accept gifts, grants, or donations from private or public sources, including from 19 20 third-party providers, for the purposes of this section; except that the department may not accept a gift, grant, or donation that is subject to 21 22 conditions that are inconsistent with this section or any other law of the 23 state. (b) (I) In addition to the fees described in subsection (1)(c) of this
section, a third-party provider shall pay the department a fee of up to
three dollars for each of the following types of transactions completed by

36 **SECTION 6.
