1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 10, before line 11 insert:

2 "SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 6-7.5-105, amend
3 (5)(j) as follows:

4 **6-7.5-105. Standards - effective dates - repeal.** (5) On and after
5 January 1, 2026, a person shall not sell, offer to sell, lease, or offer to
6 lease any of the following new products in Colorado unless the efficiency
7 of the new product meets or exceeds the following efficiency standards,
8 as applicable:

9 (j) (I) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (5)(j)(II)
10 OF THIS SECTION, residential windows, residential doors, and residential
11 skylights included in the scope of the Energy Star program product
12 specification for residential windows, doors, and skylights must satisfy
13 the northern climate zone qualification criteria of that specification;
14 except that residential windows and doors that are custom designed for
15 a historically designated building and required in order to maintain the
16 historic nature or character of such a building are not required to satisfy
17 such criteria.

18 (II) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MAY CONSULT WITH THE
19 COLORADO ENERGY OFFICE TO EVALUATE THE STANDARD SET FORTH IN
20 SUBSECTION (5)(j)(I) OF THIS SECTION FOR RESIDENTIAL WINDOWS,
21 RESIDENTIAL DOORS, AND RESIDENTIAL SKYLIGHTS. IF THE EXECUTIVE
22 DIRECTOR DETERMINES THAT THE STANDARD CANNOT REASONABLY BE
23 MET BY MANUFACTURERS OF RESIDENTIAL WINDOWS, RESIDENTIAL DOORS,
24 AND RESIDENTIAL SKYLIGHTS. THEN THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL SET
25 AN ALTERNATIVE STANDARD WHICH MAY BE APPLIED INSTEAD OF THE
26 STANDARD SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (5)(j)(I) OF THIS SECTION AND THE
27 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL DISPLAY THE ALTERNATIVE STANDARD ON
28 THE PUBLIC WEBSITE OF THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH
29 AND ENVIRONMENT NO LATER THAN JUNE 1, 2025. WHEN DECIDING
30 WHETHER THE STANDARD SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (5)(j)(I) OF THIS
31 SECTION CAN REASONABLY BE MET, THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL
32 TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THE FOLLOWING FACTORS:

33 (A) IMPACTS ON NET CONSUMER COSTS; AND

34 (B) SUPPLY CHAIN CONSTRAINTS."
