J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$53,611 cash funds from the Division of Professions and Occupations Cash Fund to the Department of Regulatory Agencies for FY 2022-23. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.3 FTE. Of that amount, \$9,517 is reappropriated to the Department of Personnel and Administration.
