Summary of Legislation

The bill corrects a statutory reference pertaining to powers and duties of the Attorney General. Specifically, the bill strikes “part 3” of article 120 of title 12 and replaces it with “part 4”.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill corrects an erroneous reference in statute. It does not change any practices for the Attorney General’s Office and has no impact on state revenues or expenditures.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
