The House Agriculture, Livestock, & Water Committee Report (04/21/22) includes amendments to the bill, however, Legislative Council Staff (LCS) and JBC Staff agree that the committee amendments do not change the fiscal impact of the bill.

There is a technical issue with the LCS Fiscal Note (04/20/22). The Fiscal Note states that the Colorado Water Conservation Board Construction Fund (the Fund) is continuously appropriated to the Department of Natural Resources and that an appropriation is not required. However, LCS and JBC Staff both agree that the Fund is annually appropriated, which means that an appropriation of \$15.0 million cash funds is required to allow the Department to spend the \$15.0 million transferred into the Fund from the Economic Recovery and Relief Cash Fund.
