The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$53,646 General Fund for FY 2023-24, inlcuding \$31,110 General Fund to the Department of Corrections, \$15,111 General Fund to the Department of Human Services, and \$7,425 General Fund to the Judicial Department. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department of Corrections will require an additional 0.4 FTE, the Judicial Department will require an additional 0.1 FTE, and the Department of Human Services will receive \$4,481 federal funds to implement the act.
