Description of Amendments in This Packet

- **J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$221,090 General Fund in FY 2021-22, comprised of the following:
- \$204,028 General Fund to the Department of Law, which states that the appropriation is

based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.8 FTE.

- \$3,900 reappropriated funds from the Department of Law to the Department of Personnel for vehicle lease costs; and
- \$17,062 General Fund to the Department of Treasury, which states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.4 FTE.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package includes a set aside of \$50.0 million General Fund for bills that require General Fund appropriations for FY 2021-22. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$221,090 for FY 2021-22, reducing the \$50.0 million set aside by the same amount.
