Bill Topic: ADMINISTRATION ORGANIZATION ACT MODERNIZATION

Summary of Fiscal Impact: No fiscal impact. The bill modernizes language in the Administration and Organization Act of 1968 and makes conforming amendments. It is assessed as having no fiscal impact on state or local governments.

Appropriation Summary: No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status: The fiscal note reflects the introduced bill, as recommended by the Statutory Revision Committee.

Summary of Legislation

The Administration Organization Act of 1968 defines state government entities as Type 1 or Type 2, and specifies how powers and duties are transferred when an entity moves from one department to another. The bill simplifies language in these definitions, eliminates the archaic Type 3 transfer, and makes conforming amendments throughout statute for clarity.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill modernizes statute and eliminates outdated language. This results in no change to state or local government revenue or expenditures, and the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect 90 days following adjournment of the General Assembly sine die, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
