A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING LEGISLATIVE REVIEW OF RULES OF THE STATE BOARD OF**
102 **EDUCATION TO IMPLEMENT THE STATEWIDE SYSTEM TO**
103 **EVALUATE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF LICENSED EDUCATORS.**

Bill Summary

Committee on Legal Services. Senate Bill 10-191, enacted in 2010, requires the general assembly to review and approve the rules adopted by the state board of education implementing a statewide system to evaluate the effectiveness of licensed personnel employed by school

districts and boards of cooperative services (statewide system). The bill contains the recommendations of the committee on legal services to approve the rules of the state board of education, department of education, adopted on November 9, 2011, to implement the statewide system.

The bill postpones the scheduled expiration of the rules on the statewide system, thereby continuing the rules.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1. Extension of rules of the state board of education**
3 **implementing the statewide system to evaluate the effectiveness of**
4 **licensed personnel employed by school districts and boards of**
5 **cooperative services.** The automatic expiration of the rules of the state
6 board of education, department of education, concerning the statewide
7 system to evaluate the effectiveness of licensed personnel employed by
8 school districts and boards of cooperative services (1 CCR 301-87),
9 which rules were adopted on November 9, 2011, and that are therefore
10 scheduled for expiration May 15, 2013, is postponed, upon the effective
11 date of this act.

12 **SECTION 2. Notice to secretary of state of extension of rules.**
13 The office of legislative legal services shall forward a copy of House Bill
14 12-1001, enacted in 2012, to the secretary of state for purposes of
15 informing the secretary of state of the general assembly's actions set forth
16 in section 1 of this act regarding the extension of rules of the state board
17 of education. The secretary of state shall include an appropriate reference
18 of such extensions affecting the rules in the code of Colorado regulations
19 consistent with the provisions of section 24-4-103 (11), Colorado Revised
20 Statutes.

21 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,

- 1 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
- 2 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
