A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A FALLEN HEROES LICENSE PLATE, AND IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://www.leg.state.co.us/billsummaries.)

The bill creates the fallen heroes license plate. A person becomes eligible to use the plate by donating \$50 to the Colorado chapter of the concerns of police survivors. In addition to the normal motor vehicle fees, the plate requires 2 one-time fees of \$25. One of the fees is credited to the highway users tax fund and the other to the licensing services cash fund.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 42-3-241 as
3	follows:
4	42-3-241. Special plates - fallen heroes. (1) Beginning the
5	EARLIER OF JANUARY 1, 2013, OR WHEN THE DEPARTMENT IS ABLE TO
6	ISSUE THE PLATES, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE SPECIAL LICENSE
7	PLATES TO QUALIFIED APPLICANTS UNDER THIS SECTION FOR
8	MOTORCYCLES, PASSENGER CARS, TRUCKS, OR NONCOMMERCIAL OR
9	RECREATIONAL MOTOR VEHICLES THAT DO NOT EXCEED SIXTEEN
10	THOUSAND POUNDS EMPTY WEIGHT.
11	(2) (a) There is hereby established the fallen heroes
12	SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE. THE DEPARTMENT MAY STOP ISSUING THE FALLEN
13	HEROES SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE IF A TOTAL OF THREE THOUSAND LICENSE
14	PLATES ARE NOT ISSUED BY JULY 1, 2017. A PERSON WHO WAS ISSUED A
15	FALLEN HEROES SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2017, MAY
16	CONTINUE TO USE THE FALLEN HEROES SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE AFTER
17	JULY 1, 2017, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE DEPARTMENT STOPS ISSUING
18	THE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE.
19	(b) The Colorado Chapter of the Concerns of Police
20	SURVIVORS, INC., MAY DESIGN THE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE IF THE PLATE
21	CONFORMS WITH STANDARDS ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
22	(3) (a) A PERSON MAY APPLY FOR A FALLEN HEROES LICENSE
23	PLATE IF THE PERSON PAYS THE TAXES AND FEES REQUIRED UNDER THIS
24	SECTION AND PROVIDES TO THE DEPARTMENT OR AN AUTHORIZED AGENT
25	A CERTIFICATE, ISSUED BY THE COLORADO CHAPTER OF THE CONCERNS OF

- (b) THE COLORADO CHAPTER OF THE CONCERNS OF POLICE SURVIVORS, INC., OR ITS SUCCESSOR ORGANIZATION, SHALL FILE WITH THE DEPARTMENT AN ANNUAL STATEMENT VERIFYING THAT IT IS A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION.
- (4) THE AMOUNT OF THE TAXES AND FEES FOR SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION ARE THE SAME AS THE AMOUNT OF THE TAXES AND FEES FOR REGULAR MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES; EXCEPT THAT THE DEPARTMENT SHALL COLLECT A ONE-TIME FEE OF TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS FOR ISSUANCE OR REPLACEMENT OF THE LICENSE PLATE. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL TRANSMIT THE ADDITIONAL ONE-TIME FEE TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE FEE TO THE HIGHWAY USERS TAX FUND CREATED IN SECTION 43-4-201, C.R.S.
 - (5) An applicant may apply for personalized fallenheroes special license plates. Upon payment of the additional fee required by section 42-3-211 (6) (a) for personalized license plates, the department may issue the plates if the applicant complies with section 42-3-211. If an applicant has existing personalized license plates for a motor vehicle, the applicant may transfer the combination of letters or numbers to a new set of fallen heroes special license plates for the vehicle upon paying the fee required by section 42-3-211 (6) (a) and upon turning in the existing plates to the department. A person who has obtained personalized fallen heroes special license plates under this subsection (5) shall pay the annual fee imposed by section 42-3-211 (6) (b) for renewal of the personalized plates.

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1 THE FEES UNDER THIS SUBSECTION (5) ARE IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER 2 APPLICABLE TAXES AND FEES. 3 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 42-3-312 as 4 follows: 5 **42-3-312. Special license plate surcharge.** In addition to any 6 other fee imposed by this article, an applicant for a special license plate 7 created by rule in accordance with section 42-3-207, as such section 8 existed when the plate was created, or license plates issued pursuant to 9 sections 42-3-211 to 42-3-218, sections 42-3-221 to 42-3-234, and 10 sections 42-3-237 to 42-3-240 42-3-241 shall pay an issuance fee of 11 twenty-five dollars; except that the fee is not imposed on special license 12 plates exempted from additional fees for the issuance of a military special 13 license plate by section 42-3-213 (1) (b) (II). The department shall 14 transfer the fee to the state treasurer, who shall credit it to the licensing 15 services cash fund created in section 42-2-114.5. 16 **SECTION 3.** Appropriation. (1) In addition to any other 17 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the 18 Colorado state titling and registration account of the highway users tax 19 fund created in section 42-1-211 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, not 20 otherwise appropriated, to the department of revenue, information 21 technology division, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012, the sum 22 of \$2,960, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the 23 implementation of this act. 24 In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby 25 appropriated to the governor - lieutenant governor - state planning and 26 budgeting, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012, the sum of \$2,960, 27 or so much thereof as may be necessary, for allocation to the office of

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information technology for the provision of programming services to the department of revenue related to the implementation of this act. Said sum is from reappropriated funds received from the department of revenue out of the appropriation made in subsection (1) of this section.

(3) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the license plate cash fund created in section 42-3-301 (1) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of revenue, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012, the sum of \$17,760, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for allocation to the division of motor vehicles, for the purchase of license plates related to the implementation of this act.

SECTION 4. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 7, 2012, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2012); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2012 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

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
