A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE CREATION OF A PREGNANCY-BASED PARKING PLACARD.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://leg.colorado.gov.)

The bill creates a pregnancy-based parking placard. The placard is available to a person during the last trimester of the person's pregnancy through the first 2 months after the person gives birth. The placard authorizes the person to park in reserved disability parking spaces.

2	SECTION 1. Short title. The short title of this act is the
3	"Expecting Mothers' Relief Act".
4	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-204, amend
5	$(1)(a), (1)(f), and (5)(h)(I)(A); and \ {\bf add} \ (3)(a)(I.5) \ and (6)(a.5) \ as \ follows:$
6	42-3-204. Reserved parking - persons with disabilities -
7	pregnancy - definitions - rules. (1) Definitions. As used in this section:
8	(a) "Disability" or "disabled" means a physical impairment that
9	meets the standards of 23 CFR 1235. "DISABILITY" INCLUDES THE LAST
10	TRIMESTER OF A PERSON'S PREGNANCY THROUGH THE FIRST TWO MONTHS
11	AFTER THE PERSON GIVES BIRTH.
12	(f) "Identifying placard" means a placard bearing an identifying
13	figure issued under this section or a similar provision in another state and
14	refers to a ninety-day, PREGNANCY-BASED, three-year, or permanent
15	placard.
16	(3) Types of plates or placards. (a) Authorization. The
17	department may issue the following registration type for issuing disabled
18	plates and placards that notify the public that the vehicle transports a
19	person who may use reserved parking:
20	(I.5) A PREGNANCY-BASED IDENTIFYING PLACARD.
21	(5) Issuance of plate or placard - rules. (h) Requirements for
22	issuance of identifying placards or plates. (I) To qualify for an
23	identifying placard or plate, an individual must submit:
24	(A) A written statement, made by a professional on a form
25	published by the department, that the person EITHER has a physical
26	impairment meeting the standards of 23 CFR 1235 OR THAT THE PERSON

1	AFTER GIVING BIRTH, and that the impairment is expected to be temporary,
2	last thirty months, or be permanent, as the case may be;
3	(6) Expiration and renewal. (a.5) Pregnancy-based identifying
4	placards. A PREGNANCY-BASED IDENTIFYING PLACARD EXPIRES ON THE
5	LAST DAY OF THE MONTH IN WHICH THE SIXTIETH DAY AFTER GIVING BIRTH
6	OCCURS. THE HOLDER MAY APPLY FOR A PLACARD BY MEETING THE
7	REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (5)(h)(I) OF THIS SECTION. THE
8	DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT RENEW A PLACARD ISSUED PURSUANT TO THIS
9	SUBSECTION (6)(a.5).
10	SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
11	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
12	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
13	that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
14	of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
15	act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
16	effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
17	November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
18	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
