A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING ADDITIONAL SOURCES OF MONEYS TO BE CREDITED TO  
102 THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT CASH FUND.

Bill Summary

The sources of moneys to be credited to the legislative department cash fund are expanded to include moneys collected or otherwise received by the general assembly, the house of representatives, the senate, and any legislative service agency, as well as any moneys transferred to the fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-2-1601, **amend** (1)  
3 as follows:

4           **2-2-1601. Legislative department cash fund - redistricting**  
5 **account - creation.** (1) There is hereby created in the state treasury the  
6 legislative department cash fund. The fund shall be comprised of such  
7 moneys that the general assembly, the house of representatives, the  
8 senate, or any legislative service agency accepts as gifts, grants, or  
9 donations, COLLECTS, OR OTHERWISE RECEIVES from private and public  
10 sources and any other moneys appropriated OR TRANSFERRED to the fund.  
11 All interest earned on the investment of moneys in the fund shall be  
12 credited to the fund. Any moneys credited to the fund and unexpended at  
13 the end of any given fiscal year shall remain in the fund and shall not  
14 revert to the general fund.

15           **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
16 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
17 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
