# A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH

101 CONCERNING THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH 102 THE REINTRODUCTION OF GRAY WOLVES IN THE STATE BE PAID

103 EXCLUSIVELY FROM THE GENERAL FUND.

### **Bill Summary**

At the 2020 general election, the voters approved proposition 114, which requires the reintroduction and management of gray wolves. The bill requires all costs for this program to be paid exclusively from the general fund, and this includes any losses of livestock caused by gray wolves.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-2-105.8, amend
3	(2)(e) introductory portion, (2)(e)(II), and (4)(a) as follows:
4	33-2-105.8. Reintroduction of gray wolves on designated lands
5	west of the continental divide - public input in commission
6	development of restoration plan - compensation to owners of
7	<b>livestock - definitions.</b> (2) Notwithstanding any provision of state law
8	to the contrary, including section 33-2-105.5 (2), and in order to restore
9	gray wolves to the state, the commission shall:
10	(e) Oversee gray wolf restoration and management, including the
11	distribution of state funds that are made available MONEY APPROPRIATED
12	FROM THE GENERAL FUND to:
13	(II) Pay fair compensation to owners of livestock for any losses
14	of livestock caused by gray wolves, as verified pursuant to the claim
15	procedures authorized by sections 33-3-107 to 33-3-110. and, to the
16	extent they are available, from moneys in the wildlife cash fund as
17	provided in section 33-3-107 (2.5).
18	(4) In furtherance of this section and the expressed intent of
19	voters, the general assembly:
20	(a) Shall make such appropriations EXCLUSIVELY FROM THE
21	GENERAL FUND as are necessary to fund the programs authorized and
22	obligations, including fair compensation for livestock losses that are
23	authorized by this section, but cannot be paid from moneys in the wildlife
24	cash fund, imposed by this section; and
25	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
