A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING AN INCREASE IN THE LENGTH OF TERMS SERVED BY  
102 MEMBERS OF THE STATE CONSERVATION BOARD.

**Bill Summary**

The bill increases from 3 to 4 years the length of terms served by members of the state conservation board in the department of agriculture.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

1           **SECTION 1.** 35-70-103 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read:

3           **35-70-103. State conservation board - composition - powers.**

4           (2) At the first regular meeting of the state board in 1974, the nine  
5 elected and appointed members of the state board shall by lot determine  
6 which three shall hold office for terms of three years, which three for  
7 terms of two years, and which three for terms of one year. Thereafter, all  
8 such elected and appointed members shall hold office for terms of ~~three~~  
9 FOUR years.

10           **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -**

11 **applicability.** (1) This act shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day  
12 following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment  
13 of the general assembly (August 10, 2011, if adjournment sine die is on  
14 May 11, 2011); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to  
15 section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an  
16 item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item,  
17 section, or part shall not take effect unless approved by the people at the  
18 general election to be held in November 2012 and shall take effect on the  
19 date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

20           (2) The provisions of this act shall apply to members of the state  
21 conservation board elected or appointed on or after the applicable  
22 effective date of this act.
