CONCERNING CLARIFYING THAT THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AND DEFENSE COUNSEL EXEMPTION FOR SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF A CHILD CRIME DOES NOT CHANGE THE DISCOVERY PROCEDURES FOR SEXUALLY EXPLOITATIVE MATERIAL.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-6-403, **add** (8) as follows:

18-6-403. Sexual exploitation of a child - legislative declaration - definitions. (8) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION CHANGES THE DISCOVERY PROCEDURE FOR SEXUALLY EXPLOITATIVE MATERIAL AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 16-9-601.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
