Bill Summary

The bill authorizes a person who purchases an alcohol beverage at the Colorado state fair to consume and possess the drink anywhere within the state fair that is licensed for consumption of alcohol. SENATE Am ended 2nd Reading

declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
