### A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING PERMITTING THE TRANSFER OF A MARIJUANA 102 TRANSPORTER LICENSE WITH A CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP.

## **Bill Summary**

Under current law, a marijuana transporter license cannot be transferred with a change of ownership. The bill removes this prohibition.

| 21 | SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act                   |
| 22 | takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the           |
