# A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 101 CONCERNING THE PROHIBITION AGAINST A CARRIER REQUIRING STEP
- 102 THERAPY FOR COVERED PERSONS WITH STAGE FOUR ADVANCED
- 103 METASTATIC CANCER.

### **Bill Summary**

The bill prohibits a carrier that issues a health benefit plan that covers treatment for stage four advanced metastatic cancer from requiring a cancer patient to undergo step therapy prior to receiving a drug approved by the United States food and drug administration if use of the approved drug is consistent with best practices for treatment of the HOUSE 3rd Reading Unamended February 26, 2018

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-16-145, amend
3 (1) as follows:

**10-16-145.** Step therapy - prohibited - definitions. (1) For the
purposes of this section AND SECTION 10-16-145.5, "step therapy" means
a protocol that requires a covered person to use a prescription drug or
sequence of prescription drugs, other than the drug that the covered
person's health care provider recommends for the covered person's
treatment, before the carrier provides coverage for the recommended
prescription drug.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 10-16-145.5 as
follows:

13 10-16-145.5. Step therapy prohibited - stage four advanced 14 metastatic cancer - definition. (1) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 15 10-16-145, A CARRIER THAT PROVIDES COVERAGE UNDER A HEALTH 16 BENEFIT PLAN FOR THE TREATMENT OF STAGE FOUR ADVANCED 17 METASTATIC CANCER SHALL NOT LIMIT OR EXCLUDE COVERAGE UNDER 18 THE HEALTH BENEFIT PLAN FOR A DRUG APPROVED BY THE UNITED STATES 19 FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION AND THAT IS ON THE CARRIER'S 20 PRESCRIPTION DRUG FORMULARY BY MANDATING THAT A COVERED 21 PERSON WITH STAGE FOUR ADVANCED METASTATIC CANCER UNDERGO 22 STEP THERAPY IF THE USE OF THE APPROVED DRUG IS CONSISTENT WITH: 23 THE **S**TATES (a) UNITED FOOD AND DRUG 24 ADMINISTRATION-APPROVED INDICATION OR THE NATIONAL 25 COMPREHENSIVE CANCER NETWORK DRUGS AND BIOLOGICS COMPENDIUM 1 INDICATION FOR THE TREATMENT OF STAGE FOUR ADVANCED METASTATIC

2 CANCER; OR

(b) PEER-REVIEWED MEDICAL LITERATURE.

4 (2) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "STAGE FOUR ADVANCED
5 METASTATIC CANCER" MEANS CANCER THAT HAS SPREAD FROM THE
6 PRIMARY OR ORIGINAL SITE OF THE CANCER TO NEARBY TISSUES, LYMPH
7 NODES, OR OTHER PARTS OF THE BODY.

8 **SECTION 3.** Act subject to petition - effective date -9 **applicability.** (1) This act takes effect January 1, 2019; except that, if a 10 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 11 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 12 within the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general 13 assembly, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless 14 approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 15 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on January 1, 2019, or on the date 16 of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor, whichever 17 is later.

18 (2) This act applies to health benefit plans issued, amended, or19 renewed on or after the applicable effective date of this act.
