## A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE REGULATION OF VESSELS BY 102

## THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

## **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Sunset process - House Agriculture, Livestock, and Natural **Resources** Committee. Currently, machine- or sail-powered vessels are required to be annually registered with the department of natural resources. The bill repeals the sunset of this requirement, which extends the required annual registration of vessels indefinitely.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, amend
3	(57) (c); <b>repeal</b> (47.5) (e); and <b>add</b> (57) (d) as follows:
4	24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies
5	and functions for termination, continuation, or reestablishment.
6	(47.5) The following agencies, functions, or both, shall terminate on
7	September 1, 2016:
8	(e) The registration and regulation of vessels by the department of
9	natural resources in accordance with article 13 of title 33, C.R.S.;
10	(57) The following agencies, functions, or both, terminate on
11	September 1, 2026:
12	(c) The securities board, created in section 11-51-702.5, C.R.S.;
13	AND
14	(d) THE REGISTRATION AND REGULATION OF VESSELS BY THE
15	DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 13
16	OF TITLE 33, C.R.S.
17	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-13-107, amend
18	(1) as follows:
19	<b>33-13-107.</b> Vessel liveries. (1) The owner or operator of a vessel
20	livery shall keep a record of the name and address of each person who
21	hires any vessel that is designed or permitted to be operated as a vessel,
22	the HULL identification number of such THE vessel, and the departure date
23	and time and the expected date and time of return of such THE vessel.
24	Such records shall be preserved for at least thirty days after such THE
25	vessel is to be returned and shall be subject to inspection by the division.
26	Any person who violates this subsection (1) is guilty of a class 2 petty

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1	offense and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of one hundred
2	dollars.
3	SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 33-13-116 as
4	follows:
5	<b>33-13-116.</b> Repeal of sections. Sections 33-13-103, 33-13-104,
6	33-13-105, and 33-13-107 are repealed, effective September 1, 2016
7	SEPTEMBER 1, 2026. Prior to the repeal, the function of registration and
8	regulation of vessels shall be reviewed as provided for in section
9	24-34-104, C.R.S.
10	SECTION 4. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
11	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
12	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
13	10, 2016, if adjournment sine die is on May 11, 2016); except that, if a
14	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
15	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
16	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
17	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
18	November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
19	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

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
