**HOUSE BILL 10-1173** 

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#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING CIRCUMSTANCES IN WHICH THE FEE FOR LATE REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE IS NOT IMPOSED.

### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill specifies that, on and after July 1, 2010, the fee for late registration of a vehicle shall not be imposed for any portion of the calendar month in which a temporary registration number plate, tag, or certificate expires. The bill also authorizes the department of revenue or an authorized agent of the department to waive the fee if the department

or authorized agent determines that the failure to timely register the vehicle resulted from extenuating circumstances beyond the control of the vehicle owner.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

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SECTION 1. 42-3-112 (1) and (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, are amended to read:

**42-3-112.** Failure to pay tax - penalty. (1) If a vehicle subject to taxation under this article is not registered when required by law, the vehicle owner shall pay IS SUBJECT TO a late fee of twenty-five dollars for each month or portion of a month following the expiration of the registration period, or, if applicable, the expiration of the grace period described in section 42-3-114 for which the vehicle is unregistered; except that, on and after July 1, 2010, the late fee shall not be IMPOSED FOR ANY PORTION OF THE CALENDAR MONTH IN WHICH A TEMPORARY REGISTRATION NUMBER PLATE, TAG, OR CERTIFICATE ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTION 42-3-203 EXPIRES AND EXCEPT THAT the amount of the late fee shall not exceed one hundred dollars. The late fee shall be due when the vehicle is registered. THE DEPARTMENT OR THE AUTHORIZED AGENT REGISTERING THE VEHICLE MAY WAIVE THE LATE FEE IF THE DEPARTMENT OR THE AUTHORIZED AGENT DETERMINES THAT THE FAILURE TO TIMELY REGISTER THE VEHICLE RESULTED FROM EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE VEHICLE OWNER.

(2) Ten dollars of the EACH late registration fee COLLECTED shall be retained by the department or the authorized agent who registers the motor vehicle. Each authorized agent shall remit to the department no less frequently than once a month, but otherwise at the time and in the

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manner required by the executive director of the department, the 1 2 remainder of the late registration fees collected by the authorized agent. 3 The executive director shall forward all late registration fees remitted by 4 authorized agents plus the remainder of the late registration fees collected 5 directly by the department to the state treasurer, who shall credit the fees 6 to the highway users tax fund in accordance with section 43-4-804 (1) (e), 7 C.R.S. **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 8 9 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
