	A BILL FOR AN ACT
101	CONCERNING THE JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE REVIEW OF
102	DEPARTMENTAL BUDGET REQUESTS AS PART OF THE "STATE
103	MEASUREMENT FOR ACCOUNTABLE, RESPONSIVE, AND
104	TRANSPARENT (SMART) GOVERNMENT ACT" HEARINGS.

### **Bill Summary**

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill changes the deadlines for state agencies to submit their budget requests to the general assembly in order for each joint committee of reference assigned to a particular state department to hear that department's budget request, budget request amendment, or request for supplemental appropriation prior to the presentation of such matters to the joint budget committee. The bill requires the joint committee of reference to provide to the joint budget committee, at a joint meeting, any recommendations regarding the budget request no later than November 1 and any recommendations regarding budget request amendments or requests for supplemental appropriations no later than January 15. The bill requires the joint budget committee liaison assigned to the joint committee of reference to notify the joint committee of reference which recommendations the joint budget committee did or did not adopt in the joint budget committee's appropriations recommendations to the appropriations committees. The bill also requires the staff of the joint budget committee to provide budget analyses to the joint committees of reference

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

**SECTION 1. Legislative declaration.** (1) The general assembly hereby finds and declares that:

- (a) Because the joint committees of reference are already the experts on the departments they oversee, it makes good policy sense for the departments to present their budget requests to the joint committees of reference;
- (b) This process will also improve the usefulness of the "State Measurement for Accountable, Responsive, and Transparent (SMART) Government Act" hearings because not only will the joint committees of reference have the expertise about that particular department, the joint committees of reference will be hearing about the department's budget requests at the same time that the department will present its performance plan and regulatory agenda, ensuring that all work together from a policy perspective;
- (c) Since a department's budget affects the department's performance plan, it is imperative that the joint committee of reference

1	has a say in the budget of the department that they oversee; and
2	(d) The joint committees of reference will provide the joint budget
3	committee with expertise on each department that will be useful to the
4	joint budget committee and will foster a closer working relationship with
5	all of the general assembly in finalizing the state's budget each year.
6	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 2-3-208 as
7	follows:
8	2-3-208. Budget requests - amendments - supplemental
9	appropriation requests - deadlines - definitions. (1) As used in this
10	section, unless the context otherwise requires:
11	(a) "Budget request amendment" means any change to a budget
12	request for the upcoming state fiscal year that a state agency submits to
13	the joint budget committee.
14	(b) "JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE" MEANS THE JOINT MEETING
15	OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND SENATE COMMITTEES OF
16	REFERENCE ASSIGNED TO EACH STATE AGENCY PURSUANT TO SECTION
17	2-7-203.
18	(b) (c) "State agency" means any department, commission,
19	council, board, bureau, committee, institution of higher education,
20	agency, or other governmental unit of the executive, legislative, or
21	judicial branch of state government that receives an appropriation or is
22	otherwise included in the annual general appropriation act.
23	(2) (a) A state agency shall submit its budget request for the
24	upcoming state fiscal year to the joint budget committee AND TO ITS
25	ASSIGNED JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE by November 1 OCTOBER 1.
26	Except as set forth in paragraph (b) of this subsection (2) SUBSECTION
27	(2)(b) OF THIS SECTION, the state agency shall submit any budget request

amendments to the joint budget committee AND TO ITS ASSIGNED JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE by January 15 DECEMBER 15.

- (b) (I) A state agency shall submit a budget request amendment that is related to a request for a supplemental appropriation to the joint budget committee AND TO ITS ASSIGNED JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE by January 2 DECEMBER 2; except that the January 2 DECEMBER 2 deadline does not apply to a budget request amendment that is related to a request for a supplemental appropriation identified in subparagraph (I) of paragraph (b) of subsection (3) SUBSECTION (3)(b)(I) of this section.
  - (II) A state agency may submit a budget request amendment to the joint budget committee AND TO ITS ASSIGNED JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE after its applicable deadline if the budget request amendment is based upon circumstances unknown to, and not reasonably foreseeable by, the state agency prior to the deadline.
  - (c) Any deadline in this subsection (2) is the date immediately preceding the state fiscal year that is the subject of the budget request or budget request amendment.
  - (3) (a) Except as set forth in paragraph (b) of this subsection (3) SUBSECTION (3)(b) OF THIS SECTION, a state agency shall submit a request for a supplemental appropriation for the current state fiscal year to the joint budget committee AND TO ITS ASSIGNED JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE by January 2 DECEMBER 2.
  - (b) (I) The department of education shall submit a request for a supplemental appropriation pursuant to section 22-54-106 (4)(b) to the joint budget committee AND TO ITS ASSIGNED JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE by January 15 DECEMBER 15. The department of corrections and the division of youth services in the department of human services

shall each submit a request for a supplemental appropriation related to changes in caseload to the joint budget committee AND TO ITS ASSIGNED JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE by January 15 DECEMBER 15.

- (II) A state agency may submit a request for a supplemental appropriation to the joint budget committee AND TO ITS ASSIGNED JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE after its applicable deadline if the supplemental appropriation is based upon circumstances unknown to, and not reasonably foreseeable by, the state agency prior to the deadline.
- (c) Any deadline in this subsection (3) is the date during the state fiscal year that the request for a supplemental appropriation is made.
- (4) The office of state planning and budgeting may submit a request identified in this section to the joint budget committee AND TO THE STATE AGENCY'S ASSIGNED JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE on behalf of a state agency, and in such case, the corresponding deadline for the request applies to the office.
- SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-7-203, amend (2)(a) and (3)(b); and add (2)(a.7) as follows:
  - **2-7-203.** Departmental presentations to legislative committees of reference departmental regulatory agendas. (2) (a) (I) Each joint committee of reference shall conduct at least one but not more than three hearings during the interim between legislative sessions between November 1 October 1 and the commencement of the following regular legislative session, during which hearings the joint committee shall hear a presentation from each department that is assigned to such committee pursuant to subsection (1) of this section regarding:
  - (H) (A) The department's performance plan developed pursuant to section 2-7-204 (3);

1	(H) (B) The department's regulatory agenda required pursuant to
2	subsection (4) of this section; and
3	(HH) (C) The department's budget request PROVIDED TO THE JOINT

5	TO SECTION 2-3-208 and associated legislative agenda for the upcoming
6	regular legislative session.
7	(II) EACH JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE MAY CONDUCT
8	HEARINGS DURING THE LEGISLATIVE SESSION AS NECESSARY IN ORDER TO
9	HEAR DEPARTMENTAL BUDGET REQUEST AMENDMENTS OR REQUESTS FOR
10	SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS PROVIDED TO THE JOINT COMMITTEE OF
11	REFERENCE AND THE JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE PURSUANT TO SECTION
12	2-3-208.
13	(III) EACH JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE MAY HOLD AS MANY
14	HEARINGS AS NECESSARY TO FULFILL THE JOINT COMMITTEE'S
15	RESPONSIBILITIES SET FORTH IN SUBSECTIONS $(2)(a)(I)$ AND $(2)(a)(II)$ OF
16	THIS SECTION.
17	(a.7) (I) EACH JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE SHALL REVIEW A
18	DEPARTMENT'S BUDGET REQUEST, CONSIDER THE DEPARTMENT'S
19	PRESENTATION, AND THE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE FROM EACH HOUSE
20	SHALL MAKE WRITTEN RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING THE
21	DEPARTMENT'S BUDGET REQUEST TO THE JOINT BUDGET COMMITTEE NO
22	LATER THAN NOVEMBER 1.
23	(II) EACH JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE SHALL REVIEW A
24	DEPARTMENT'S BUDGET REQUEST AMENDMENTS OR REQUESTS FOR
25	SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS, CONSIDER THE DEPARTMENT'S
26	PRESENTATION, AND THE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE FROM EACH HOUSE
27	SHALL MAKE WRITTEN RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING THE

6	(3) (b) The chair of the joint budget committee shall assign one
7	member of the joint budget committee to serve as a liaison for each
8	department. The joint budget committee liaison shall inform the joint
9	committee of reference regarding the department's performance
10	management system and performance plan AND SHALL INFORM THE
11	COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE FROM EACH HOUSE, IN WRITING, WHICH
12	COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE RECOMMENDATIONS REGARDING THE

19	SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-204, amend (1)
20	as follows:
21	2-3-204. Staff director, assistants, and consultants - definition.
22	(1) (a) The committee shall interview persons applying for the position
23	of staff director as to qualifications and ability and shall make
24	recommendations thereon to the executive committee, which shall appoint
25	the staff director as provided in section 2-3-303 (3). The staff director
26	shall be responsible to the committee AND EACH JOINT COMMITTEE OF
27	REFERENCE for the collection and assembling of all data and the

preparation of reports and recommendations. The staff director shall also be responsible for preparing for consideration by the committee AND EACH JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE analyses of all requests for funds. With the approval of the committee, the staff director may appoint such additional professional, technical, clerical, or other employees necessary to perform the functions assigned to the committee AND EACH JOINT COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE. The staff director and such additional personnel shall be appointed without reference to affiliation and solely on the basis of ability to perform the duties of the position. They shall be employees of the general assembly and shall not be subject to the state personnel system laws. The committee shall establish appropriate qualifications and compensation for all positions. With the consent of the committee, the chairperson may contract for professional services by private consultants as needed.

(b) For purposes of this section, "joint committee of reference" has the same meaning as specified in section 2-7-208 (1).

SECTION 5. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 8, 2018, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2018); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
