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A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING A REVERSAL OF THE ANNUAL PAYDAY SHIFT AS IT APPLIES TO STATE EMPLOYEES PAID ON A BIWEEKLY BASIS, AND

103 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. As a result of the payday shift effected by Senate Bill 03-197, payment to state employees who are paid on a biweekly basis is delayed from late June to the first working day in July each year. Commencing with the 2012-13 state fiscal year, the bill

reverses the payday shift for state employees who are paid on a biweekly basis so that such employees will be paid in June in accordance with their regular 2-week payment schedule.
