A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING A REVERSAL OF THE ANNUAL PAYDAY SHIFT AS IT
102 APPLIES TO STATE EMPLOYEES PAID ON A BIWEEKLY BASIS, AND
103 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. As a result of the payday shift effected by Senate Bill 03-197, payment to state employees who are paid on a biweekly basis is delayed from late June to the first working day in July each year. Commencing with the 2012-13 state fiscal year, the bill

reverses the payday shift for state employees who are paid on a biweekly basis so that such employees will be paid in June in accordance with their regular 2-week payment schedule.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-50-104, **amend**
3 (8) (a.6) as follows:

4 **24-50-104. Job evaluation and compensation. (8) Payroll.**
5 (a.6) For state employment positions that are not otherwise covered by
6 paragraph (a) or (a.5) of this subsection (8), whether or not ~~such~~ THE
7 positions are in the state personnel system:

8 (I) Salaries paid on a biweekly basis for the pay period
9 commencing on May 31, 2003, and ending on June 13, 2003, shall be
10 paid on July 1, 2003; ~~and~~

11 (II) Effective July 1, 2003, FOR WORK PERFORMED THROUGH JUNE
12 30, 2012, salaries paid on a biweekly basis for the fourteen-day pay period
13 preceding the first fourteen-day pay period for which salaries paid on a
14 biweekly basis for any work performed during the month of June are paid
15 on or after July 1 shall be paid on the first working day of July; AND

16 (III) EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2012, SALARIES PAID ON A BIWEEKLY
17 BASIS SHALL BE PAID FOURTEEN DAYS AFTER THE LAST DAY OF THE
18 FOURTEEN-DAY PAY PERIOD.

19 **SECTION 2. Appropriation.** In addition to any other
20 appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the
21 general fund not otherwise appropriated, for the fiscal year beginning July
22 1, 2012, the sum of \$1,692,097, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
23 to be allocated for the implementation of this act as follows:

18 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
19 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
20 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
