Bill Summary

Sunset Process - House Health and Human Services Committee. The suicide prevention commission created in the department of public health and environment is scheduled to repeal on September 1, 2024. Pursuant to the recommendation in the department of regulatory agencies' sunset review and report, the bill continues the suicide prevention commission indefinitely.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal**
3 (15)(a)(III) as follows:

4 **2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative**
5 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (15) (a) The following statutory
6 authorizations for the designated advisory committees are scheduled for
7 repeal on September 1, 2024:

10 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25-1.5-111, **repeal**
11 (6) as follows:

12 **25-1.5-111. Suicide prevention commission - created -**
13 **responsibilities - gifts, grants, or donations - reimbursement for**
14 **expenses - definition.** (6) ~~(a) This section is repealed, effective~~
15 ~~September 1, 2024.~~

18 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
19 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
20 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
21 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
22 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
23 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
24 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in

1 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
2 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
