# A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE REPEAL OF THE PROVISION AWARDING A DEFENDANT ATTORNEY FEES IN A TORT ACTION WHEN THE CASE IS DISMISSED ON MOTION OF THE DEFENDANT PRIOR TO TRIAL.

## **Bill Summary**

Under current law, a defendant may be awarded reasonable attorney fees in tort actions if the case is dismissed on motion of the defendant prior to trial. The bill eliminates this provision.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, repeal 13-17-201 as
3	follows:
4	13-17-201. Award of reasonable attorney fees in certain cases.
5	In all actions brought as a result of a death or an injury to person or
6	property occasioned by the tort of any other person, where any such
7	action is dismissed on motion of the defendant prior to trial under rule 12
8	(b) of the Colorado rules of civil procedure, such defendant shall have
9	judgment for his reasonable attorney fees in defending the action. This
10	section shall not apply if a motion under rule 12 (b) of the Colorado rules
11	of civil procedure is treated as a motion for summary judgment and
12	disposed of as provided in rule 56 of the Colorado rules of civil
13	<del>procedure.</del>
14	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, repeal 13-20-1206
15	as follows:
16	13-20-1206. Attorney fees. Section 13-17-201, which requires an
17	award of attorney fees to defendants in certain actions dismissed prior to
18	trial, does not apply to an action brought pursuant to this part 12.
19	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
20	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
21	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
