A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE SPECIFICATION OF WHAT MATERIALS MAY BI
PROVIDED IN A LANGUAGE OTHER THAN ENGLISH BY A
INSURER TO A CUSTOMER

Bill Summary

Current law allows an insurer to provide materials to its customers in a language other than English and requires that the materials also be provided in English. The bill states that if an insurer chooses to provide SENATE Std Reading Unamended

HOUSE 2nd Reading Unamended March 20, 2014 materials in another language, the insurer must also provide an English version of the insurance policy, rider, and endorsement to the customer but eliminates the requirement that explanatory or advertising materials also be provided in English.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-1-136, amend (2) 3 as follows: 4 10-1-136. Insurance policies - language other than English. 5 (2) An insurer authorized to offer insurance in this state may provide 6 insurance policies, endorsements, riders, and any explanatory or 7 advertising materials in a language other than English. If an insurer opts 8 to provide materials AN INSURANCE POLICY, ENDORSEMENT, OR RIDER to 9 the customer in a language other than English, the insurer must also 10 provide the English version of the materials at the same time. In the event 11 of a dispute or complaint regarding the insurance or advertising materials, 12 the English language version of the insurance document controls the 13 resolution of the dispute or complaint. 14 **SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 15 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 16 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 17 6, 2014, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2014); except that, if a 18 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 19 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 20 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 21 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 22 November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 23 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

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
