A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING THE COMMITTEE ON ANTICOMPETITIVE CONDUCT, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, CONTINUING THE COMMITTEE'S STATUTORY AUTHORIZATION UNTIL SEPTEMBER 1, 2013.

Bill Summary

Sunset Process - House Judiciary Committee. The bill implements the recommendations made by the department of regulatory agencies (DORA) pursuant to DORA's 2011 sunset review report of professional review committees and the committee on anticompetitive

conduct by repealing the statute that creates the committee, effective July 1, 2012, and removing references to the committee from companion statutes.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-36.5-106, add 3 (14) as follows: 4 12-36.5-106. Committee on anticompetitive conduct - repeal 5 - legislative declaration. (14) This section is repealed, effective SEPTEMBER 1, 2013. PRIOR TO SUCH REPEAL, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY 6 7 ANTICIPATES THAT THERE WILL BE, AND DECLARES ITS SUPPORT FOR, 8 CONSTRUCTIVE DISCUSSION AMONG LICENSED PROFESSIONALS AND OTHER 9 INTERESTED PARTIES TO CONSIDER THE PROPER ROLE, STRUCTURE, AND 10 FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMITTEE ON ANTICOMPETITIVE CONDUCT AND TO 11 RECOMMEND LEGISLATION ON THIS SUBJECT FOR CONSIDERATION DURING 12 THE 2013 REGULAR SESSION. 13 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-36.5-104, amend 14 (10) (a) and (10) (b) introductory portion; and **repeal** (10) (b) (I) as 15 follows: 16 12-36.5-104.
