A BILL FOR AN ACT 101 CONCERNING A MODIFICATION OF STATUTORY PROVISIONS 102 GOVERNING THE POLITICAL PARTY AFFILIATION OF MEMBERS 103 OF THE INDEPENDENT ETHICS COMMISSION TO SPECIFY THAT NO 104 MORE THAN TWO MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE

independent ethics commission (commission) shall be affiliated with the same political party. Existing statutory provisions provide that the major political parties shall have equal numbers of members appointed to the commission. The bill modifies these statutory provisions to specify that no more than 2 members of the commission shall be affiliated with the same political party, thereby conforming the statutory requirements to the provisions of the state constitution.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 **SECTION 1.** 24-18.5-101 (2) (b), Colorado Revised Statutes, is 3 amended to read: 4 24-18.5-101. Independent ethics commission - establishment 5 - membership - subpoena power - definitions. (2) (b) In connection 6 with the appointment of commission members, the major political parties 7 as defined in section 1-1-104 (22), C.R.S., shall have equal numbers of 8 NO MORE THAN TWO members appointed to the commission SHALL BE 9 AFFILIATED WITH THE SAME POLITICAL PARTY. 10 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 11 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 12 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
