CONCERNING THE EXTENSION OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT, PUBLIC SAFETY,
AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SHARING GRANT PROGRAM
DEADLINE.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-1617, **amend** (5)(d) and (7) as follows:

24-33.5-1617. Law enforcement, public safety, and criminal justice information sharing grant program - rules - fund created - definitions - repeal. (5) **Law enforcement, public safety, and criminal justice information sharing grant program fund.** (d) The state treasurer shall transfer all unexpended and unencumbered money in the fund on ~~July 1, 2022~~ **JULY 1, 2023**, to the general fund.

(7) **Repeal.** This section is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2022~~ **JULY 2, 2023**.

SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety.
