Budget Package Bill. For the 2010-11 and 2011-12 state fiscal years, the bill eliminates the transfers from the operational account of the

HOUSE 2nd Reading Unam ended February 17,2010 severance tax trust fund to the governor's energy office low-income energy assistance fund.

The bill also requires the state treasurer, on the effective date of the bill, to transfer back to the operational account of the severance tax trust fund a 2009-10 state fiscal year transfer of \$1.625 million that occurred on January 4, 2010, from the operational account of the severance tax trust fund to the department of human services low-income energy assistance fund for providing energy-related assistance to low-income households.

Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 22 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
