102	SECTION 21 OF ARTICLE X OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION IN A

## **Bill Summary**

**Budget Package Bill.** Pursuant to the declaration of a state fiscal emergency, for the 2009-10 fiscal year only, the bill expands the purposes
