Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee Budget Package Bill. On the date on which the state controller publishes the comprehensive annual financial report of the state for the fiscal year 2011-12, the state treasurer is required to transfer to the state education fund \$59 million from the

general fund surplus for the fiscal year 2011-12.

On the date on which the state controller publishes the comprehensive annual financial report of the state for the fiscal year 2012-13, the state treasurer is required to transfer to the state education fund the entire amount of the general fund surplus for the fiscal year 2012-13.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 1 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-75-220 as 3 follows: 4 24-75-220. Transfer of general fund surplus to state education 5 **fund.** (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY. 6 ON THE DATE ON WHICH THE STATE CONTROLLER PUBLISHES THE 7 COMPREHENSIVE ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT OF THE STATE FOR THE 8 FISCAL YEAR 2011-12, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER TO THE 9 STATE EDUCATION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 17 (4) OF ARTICLE IX OF 10 THE STATE CONSTITUTION FIFTY-NINE MILLION DOLLARS FROM THE 11 GENERAL FUND SURPLUS DESIGNATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 12 24-75-201 (1) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2011-12, WHICH REPRESENTS THE 13 UNRESTRICTED GENERAL FUND BALANCE AFTER THE APPLICABLE AMOUNT 14 OF RESERVE REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 24-75-201.1 (1) (d). 15 (2) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW TO THE 16 CONTRARY, ON THE DATE ON WHICH THE STATE CONTROLLER PUBLISHES 17 THE COMPREHENSIVE ANNUAL FINANCIAL REPORT OF THE STATE FOR THE 18 FISCAL YEAR 2012-13, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER TO THE 19 STATE EDUCATION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 17 (4) OF ARTICLE IX OF 20 THE STATE CONSTITUTION THE GENERAL FUND SURPLUS DESIGNATED IN 21 ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 24-75-201 (1) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2012-13, 22 WHICH REPRESENTS THE UNRESTRICTED GENERAL FUND BALANCE AFTER

3	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
4	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the

6	8, 2012, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2012); except that, if a
7	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
8	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
9	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
10	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
11	November 2012 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
12	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
