A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE PROHIBITION OF INTERNET LOTTERY.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill prohibits the Colorado lottery commission from authorizing an internet lottery in which tickets, games, or shares are sold to a person by means of the internet, telephone, or other electronic device without physical presence of the person at a licensed lottery sales agent's place of business.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-35-201, **amend**
3 (5); and **add** (4.5) as follows:

4 **24-35-201. Definitions.** As used in this part 2, unless the context
5 otherwise requires:

6 (4.5) "INTERNET LOTTERY" MEANS TICKETS, GAMES, OR SHARES
7 SOLD TO A PERSON BY MEANS OF THE INTERNET, TELEPHONE, OR OTHER
8 ELECTRONIC DEVICE WITHOUT PHYSICAL PRESENCE OF SUCH PERSON AT A
9 LICENSED LOTTERY SALES AGENT'S PLACE OF BUSINESS.

10 (5) "Lottery" means any and all lotteries created and operated
11 pursuant to this part 2, including, without limitation, the game commonly
12 known as lotto, in which prizes are awarded on the basis of designated
13 numbers conforming to numbers selected at random, electronically or
14 otherwise, by or at the direction of the commission, and any multistate
15 lottery or game that is authorized by a multistate agreement to which the
16 division is party. All references in this article to "the lottery" shall be
17 construed to include any or all lotteries within the meaning of this
18 subsection (5). "Lottery" shall not include a promotional drawing as
19 defined in subsection (8) of this section. "LOTTERY" SHALL NOT INCLUDE
20 INTERNET LOTTERY AS DEFINED IN SUBSECTION (4.5) OF THIS SECTION.

21 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-35-208, **add** (4)
22 as follows:

23 **24-35-208. Commission - powers and duties - rules.** (4) THE
24 COMMISSION SHALL NOT PROMULGATE RULES PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION
25 (1) OF THIS SECTION AUTHORIZING INTERNET LOTTERY AS DEFINED IN
26 SECTION 24-35-201 (4.5).

27 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,

- 1 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
- 2 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
