The bill eliminates the July 1, 2010, repeal of certain provisions requiring that the Colorado bureau of investigation deny the transfer of a firearm to a person if the bureau receives certain information about the person's criminal history in response to a request transmitted to the national instant criminal background check system or a search of another database.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2           **SECTION 1. Repeal.** 24-33.5-424 (3) (b) (II), Colorado Revised  
3 Statutes, is repealed as follows:

4           **24-33.5-424. National instant criminal background check**  
5 **system - state point of contact - grounds for denial of firearm transfer**  
6 **- appeal - rule-making - unlawful acts.** (3) (b) (II) ~~This paragraph (b)~~  
7 ~~shall be repealed, effective July 1, 2010.~~

8           **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
9 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
10 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
