Bill Summary

The bill eliminates the July 1, 2010, repeal of certain provisions requiring that the Colorado bureau of investigation deny the transfer of a firearm to a person if the bureau receives certain information about the person's criminal history in response to a request transmitted to the national instant criminal background check system or a search of another database.

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. Repeal. 24-33.5-424 (3) (b) (II), Colorado Revised
3	Statutes, is repealed as follows:
4	24-33.5-424. National instant criminal background check
5	system - state point of contact - grounds for denial of firearm transfer
6	- appeal - rule-making - unlawful acts. (3) (b) (II) This paragraph (b)
7	shall be repealed, effective July 1, 2010.
8	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
9	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
10	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
