(1) The 6 bureau has the following authority: 7 (r) To conduct criminal history records checks pursuant to section 8 24-72-305.3; AND 9 (s) When requested by the chief of a fire department or his 10 OR HER DESIGNEE, AND APPROVED BY THE DIRECTOR OR HIS OR HER 11 DESIGNEE, THE BUREAU MAY ASSIST IN THE INVESTIGATION OF A POSSIBLE 12 CRIME RELATED TO ARSON. WHEN SUCH A REQUEST IS MADE BY A FIRE 13 DEPARTMENT, THE FIRE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOTIFY THE APPROPRIATE 14 LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY THAT A REQUEST FOR ASSISTANCE FROM THE 15 BUREAU HAS BEEN MADE. 16 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 17 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 18 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
