HOUSE Final Reading March 6, 2017 (a) All meetings, hearings, and other proceedings of the general assembly, or either house thereof or any committee thereof, shall be conducted in a manner to ensure, at a minimum:

 (3) That requests by persons with disabilities for reasonable accommodations and for auxiliary aids and services made in connection with such meetings, hearings, or other proceedings are satisfied to the greatest extent possible consistent with the legislative branch policy on services for the disabled to provide access to programs, services, and activities of the general assembly "LEGISLATIVE BRANCH POLICY ON SERVICES FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO OFFICIAL LEGISLATIVE PROCEEDINGS OF THE COLORADO GENERAL ASSEMBLY" adopted by the executive committee of the legislative council.
