A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING A REPEAL OF THE PROHIBITION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT
102 REGULATION OF PLASTICS.

Bill Summary

The bill repeals language that prohibits local governments from banning the use or sale of specific types of plastic materials or restricting or mandating packaging or labeling of any consumer products.

1 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** 25-17-104 as
2 follows:

3 **25-17-104. Local government preemption.** ~~No unit of local~~
4 ~~government shall require or prohibit the use or sale of specific types of~~
5 ~~plastic materials or products or restrict or mandate containers, packaging,~~
6 ~~or labeling for any consumer products.~~

7 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
8 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
9 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
10 5, 2020, if adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2020); except that, if a
11 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
12 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
13 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
14 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
15 November 2020 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
16 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
