In conformity with the 2011 change of the primary election date from August to the last Tuesday in June, the schedule under the "Fair Campaign Practices Act" for making campaign finance disclosures in connection with the primary election is changed to the second Monday in HOUSE 2nd Reading Unam ended Jamiaw 27:2012

1	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:
2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 1-45-108, amend (2)
3	(a) (I) (B) as follows:
4	1-45-108. Disclosure - definition. (2) (a) (I) Except as provided
5	in subsections (2.5), (2.7), and (6) of this section, such reports that are
6	required to be filed with the secretary of state shall be filed:
7	(B) On the first Monday in July MAY and on each Monday every
8	two weeks thereafter before the primary election;
9	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
10	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
11	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
