A BILL FOR AN ACT
CONCERNING THE REPEAL DATE FOR THE TRANSFER OF MONEY FROM
COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS TO THE HOUSING ASSISTANCE FOR
PERSONS TRANSITIONING FROM THE CRIMINAL OR JUVENILE
JUSTICE SYSTEM CASH FUND.

Bill Summary

Legislative Oversight Committee Concerning the Treatment of Persons with Mental Health Disorders in the Criminal and Juvenile Justice Systems. In 2017, the general assembly enacted a

provision requiring at the end of the 2016-17 fiscal year the state treasurer to transfer unexpended and unencumbered money appropriated for community corrections programs to a new fund to assist persons transitioning from the criminal or juvenile justice systems. The act repealed the provision in 2018.

The bill eliminates the repeal of the provision so that the transfer occurs at the end of each state fiscal year.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 17-27-108, amend 3 (7) as follows: 4 17-27-108. Division of criminal justice of the department of 5 public safety - duties - community corrections contracts. 6 (7) (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, for the fiscal year 7 commencing July 1, 2016, AND FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, any 8 money appropriated from the general fund to the division of criminal 9 justice for the purposes of this article 27 that is unexpended or 10 unencumbered as of the close of that fiscal year shall not revert to the 11 general fund, and the state treasurer and the controller shall transfer such 12 money to the housing assistance for persons transitioning from the 13 criminal or juvenile justice system cash fund created pursuant to section 14 24-32-721 (4)(d). 15 (b) This subsection (7) is repealed, effective July 1, 2018. 16 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 17 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 18 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
