

#### **Bill Summary**

The bill requires the state charter school institute and each school district board of education to adopt and implement a policy requiring each school to annually provide parents and legal guardians with a paper or email copy of a standardized immunization document developed and updated, as instructed, by the department of public health and

THE 23 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL POST THE STANDARDIZED

24 IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENT ON ITS WEB SITE ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 15,
25 2011, AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER. THE STANDARDIZED DOCUMENT
26 SHALL BE UPDATED ANNUALLY AND SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NEED NOT BE
27 LIMITED TO:

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(a) A LIST OF THE IMMUNIZATIONS REQUIRED FOR ENROLLMENT IN

 (b) A LIST OF IMMUNIZATIONS CURRENTLY RECOMMENDED FOR
 CHILDREN BY THE CENTER FOR DISEASE CONTROL ADVISORY COMMITTEE
 ON IMMUNIZATION PRACTICES AND THE RECOMMENDED AGE AT WHICH
 EACH IMMUNIZATION SHOULD BE GIVEN.

7 (5) THE DOCUMENT CREATED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (4) OF
8 THIS SECTION SHALL COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 25-4-903
9 (4) REGARDING ALLOWABLE EXEMPTIONS FROM REQUIRED
10 IMMUNIZATIONS.

11 **SECTION** 6. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 12 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 13 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 14 11, 2010, if adjournment sine die is on May 12, 2010); except that, if a 15 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 16 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 17 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part shall not take effect 18 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 19 November 2010 and shall take effect on the date of the official 20 declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
