101 **CONCERNING DEVELOPING STANDARDIZED IMMUNIZATION**
102 **INFORMATION TO PROVIDE TO PARENTS.**

Bill Summary

The bill requires the state charter school institute and each school district board of education to adopt and implement a policy requiring each school to annually provide parents and legal guardians with a paper or email copy of a standardized immunization document developed and updated, as instructed, by the department of public health and

2 **SECTION 1.** 22-30.5-505, Colorado Revised Statutes, is
3 amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SUBSECTION to read:

4 **22-30.5-505. State charter school institute - institute board -**
5 **appointment - powers and duties - rules.** (16) PURSUANT TO SECTION
6 22-30.5-519, THE INSTITUTE SHALL ANNUALLY PROVIDE PARENTS AND
7 LEGAL GUARDIANS A COPY OF THE STANDARDIZED IMMUNIZATION
8 DOCUMENT DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND
9 ENVIRONMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 25-4-902 (4), C.R.S.

10 **SECTION 2.** Part 5 of article 30.5 of title 22, Colorado Revised
11 Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to
12 read:

13 **22-30.5-519. Institute charter school standardized**
14 **immunization information policy.** ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2011, THE
15 STATE CHARTER SCHOOL INSTITUTE SHALL ANNUALLY PROVIDE THE
16 PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF EACH STUDENT ENROLLED IN THE
17 INSTITUTE CHARTER SCHOOL A COPY OF THE STANDARDIZED
18 IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENT DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
19 HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 25-4-902 (4), C.R.S.
20 FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, SOLELY POSTING A COPY OF THE
21 STANDARDIZED IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENT ON A WEB SITE OR IN A
22 CENTRAL AREA OF THE SCHOOL IS NOT SUFFICIENT TO SATISFY THE NOTICE
23 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION; HOWEVER, THE INSTITUTE IS
24 ENCOURAGED TO POST A COPY OF THE STANDARDIZED IMMUNIZATION
25 DOCUMENT ON ITS WEB SITE.

1 **SECTION 3.** Article 32 of title 22, Colorado Revised Statutes, is
2 amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to read:

3 **22-32-140. Standardized immunization policy required.** ON
4 OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2011, EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION
5 SHALL ANNUALLY PROVIDE THE PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF EACH
6 STUDENT ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL A COPY OF THE STANDARDIZED
7 IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENT DEVELOPED AND UPDATED BY THE
8 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT PURSUANT TO
9 SECTION 25-4-902 (4), C.R.S. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, SOLELY
10 POSTING A COPY OF THE STANDARDIZED IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENT ON A
11 WEB SITE OR IN A CENTRAL AREA OF THE SCHOOL IS NOT SUFFICIENT TO
12 SATISFY THE NOTICE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION; HOWEVER, EACH
13 SCHOOL DISTRICT IS ENCOURAGED TO POST A COPY OF THE STANDARDIZED
14 IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENT ON ITS WEB SITE.

15 **SECTION 4.** Article 80 of title 22, Colorado Revised Statutes, is
16 amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to read:

17 **22-80-119. Standardized immunization policy required.** ON
18 OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2011, THE SCHOOL SHALL ANNUALLY PROVIDE THE
19 PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF EACH STUDENT ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL
20 A COPY OF THE STANDARDIZED IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENT DEVELOPED
21 AND UPDATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND
22 ENVIRONMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 25-4-902 (4), C.R.S. FOR PURPOSES
23 OF THIS SECTION, SOLELY POSTING A COPY OF THE STANDARDIZED
24 IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENT ON A WEB SITE OR IN A CENTRAL AREA OF THE
25 SCHOOL IS NOT SUFFICIENT TO SATISFY THE NOTICE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS
26 SECTION; HOWEVER, THE SCHOOL IS ENCOURAGED TO POST THE
27 STANDARDIZED IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENT ON ITS WEB SITE.

1 **SECTION 5.** 25-4-902, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended
2 BY THE ADDITION OF THE FOLLOWING NEW SUBSECTIONS to
3 read:

4 **25-4-902. Immunization prior to attending school -**
5 **standardized immunization information.** (4) ON OR BEFORE MARCH
6 1, 2011, THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT SHALL
7 DEVELOP AND PROVIDE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION A
8 STANDARDIZED DOCUMENT REGARDING CHILDHOOD IMMUNIZATIONS. THE
9 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL PROVIDE EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT, THE
10 STATE CHARTER SCHOOL INSTITUTE, AND THE COLORADO SCHOOL FOR THE
11 DEAF AND THE BLIND WITH A COPY OF THE STANDARDIZED DOCUMENT
12 PRIOR TO THE START OF EACH ACADEMIC YEAR. THE STANDARDIZED
13 DOCUMENT SHALL BE UPDATED ANNUALLY AND SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NEED
14 NOT BE LIMITED TO:

15 (a) A LIST OF THE IMMUNIZATIONS REQUIRED FOR ENROLLMENT IN
16 A SCHOOL AND THE AGE AT WHICH THE IMMUNIZATION IS REQUIRED; AND

17 (b) A LIST OF IMMUNIZATIONS CURRENTLY RECOMMENDED FOR
18 CHILDREN BY THE CENTER FOR DISEASE CONTROL ADVISORY COMMITTEE
19 ON IMMUNIZATION PRACTICES AND THE RECOMMENDED AGE AT WHICH
20 EACH IMMUNIZATION SHOULD BE GIVEN.

21 (5) THE DOCUMENT CREATED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (4) OF
22 THIS SECTION SHALL COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 25-4-903
23 (4) REGARDING ALLOWABLE EXEMPTIONS FROM REQUIRED
24 IMMUNIZATIONS.

25 **SECTION 6. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
26 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
27 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August

1 11, 2010, if adjournment sine die is on May 12, 2010); except that, if a
2 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
3 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
4 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part shall not take effect
5 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
6 November 2010 and shall take effect on the date of the official
7 declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
