The bill requires the state charter school institute and each school district board of education to adopt and implement a policy requiring each school to annually provide parents and legal guardians with a paper or email copy of a standardized immunization document developed and updated, as instructed, by the department of public health and

Standardized immunization policy required.** ON 18 OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2011, THE SCHOOL SHALL ANNUALLY PROVIDE THE 19 PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF EACH STUDENT ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL 20 A COPY OF THE STANDARDIZED IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENT DEVELOPED 21 AND UPDATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND 22 ENVIRONMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 25-4-902 (4), C.R.S. (4) ON OR BEFORE MARCH 6 1, 2011, THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT SHALL 7 DEVELOP AND PROVIDE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION A 8 STANDARDIZED DOCUMENT REGARDING CHILDHOOD IMMUNIZATIONS.  $\underline{THE}$ 9 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION SHALL PROVIDE EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT, THE 10 STATE CHARTER SCHOOL INSTITUTE, AND THE COLORADO SCHOOL FOR THE 11 DEAF AND THE BLIND WITH A COPY OF THE STANDARDIZED DOCUMENT 12 PRIOR TO THE START OF EACH ACADEMIC YEAR.  24 IMMUNIZATIONS.

SECTION <u>6.</u> Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
 shall take effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August

1 11, 2010, if adjournment sine die is on May 12, 2010); except that, if a 2 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 3 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 4 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part shall not take effect 5 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 6 November 2010 and shall take effect on the date of the official 7 declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
