A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING A MODIFICATION OF RETIREMENT ELIGIBILITY FOR
102 MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT
103 ASSOCIATION.

Bill Summary

A member of the public employees' retirement association (PERA) who was not an active member, inactive member, or retiree on December 31, 2016, is currently required to have 30 years of service and to have reached the age of 58 or 60, depending on the PERA division in which

the member is employed, to retire with a full retirement benefit. The bill modifies the retirement age for PERA members by requiring such members, other than state troopers, to have 30 years of service and to have reached the age of 65 to retire with a full retirement benefit.

Service retirement eligibility. 27	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act

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takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 1 2 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 3 6, 2014, if adjournment sine die is on May 7, 2014); except that, if a 4 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 5 6 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 7 November 2014 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 8 9 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
